Australia's Future Tax System Review.

We arc writing to express our deep concern about rumours that the Government may be considering changing the rules on Dividend Imputation.

We are retired having raised and educated a large family and paid taxes all our lives. Until we received the Seniors Health Card a few years ago we have never had a cent given to us by any government.

We struggled all our lives to ensure we could retire without relying on government handouts. We have a Self-Managed-Super-Fund to help us achieve this. The government should be encouraging people to retire on their own resources and not rely on government handouts.

We are greatly concerned that the Henry Review is considering changes to the tax imputation scheme. Such a move would undermine the value in Australian companies on which we rely for our income.
