The following forms my submission to the "Australia's future tax system" review as per <http://www.taxreview.treasury.gov.au/content/Content.aspx?doc=html/submissions.htm>

Raise the tax-free threshold so that students and low-income earners do not have to pay tax.

Index income tax brackets so that inflation does not result in an implicit tax increase.

Remove small deductions that are subject to abuse, such as those for clothing and laptops.

Make it possible for the majority of Australians to not submit a tax return (or to accept a pre-determined one).

Work with states to reduce payroll tax and stamp duty. Employers should not be discouraged from creating jobs; houses are already expensive enough.

Don't tax Australians who work overseas (with particular reference to Saudi Arabia and Dubai economic free zones). Why should the government tax a person in this instance when they have used no government services? Certainly don't do it at 29 cents in the dollar!
