

To whom it may concern:

Please consider the following points in your review of the current Taxation system.

1. There is far too much tax avoidance by rich people. Please do all you can to close down tax havens.
2. We need a better emphasis on renewable energy. A tax on transport and heavy industry proportional to their emitted CO² equivalent would be appropriate, to provide a \$10 Billion fund over five years for the purposes of seed funding solar power and other technologies.
3. A small tax on all foreign exchange transactions would be appropriate, perhaps .01% of every dollar above \$10000. This could be used for various purposes, including education.
4. A tax on all CEOs' wages above \$1Million annually would also be appropriate, perhaps 70% of every dollar. This could be used for various purposes, including developing public housing.
5. Tax credits should be granted for all foreign aid support, 10c off every dollar of one's tax bill for every dollar donated to foreign aid.
6. Tax credits should be granted for all public school students, paid directly to the schools, \$5000 p.a. per student in years K-6 and \$10000 p.a. per student in years 7-12.
